This year our P&C have chosen to run the Colour Crusade without the assistance of an outside company. This is to ensure that all the profits go directly towards the adventure playground! This means that there are a few changes to how we are fundraising this year.

When: The Colour Crusade will be held on **Friday, 13th March 2020, at 1.30PM**

Who: All students from K-6 will be able to participate. We would also love parents, grandparents, preschoolers/siblings to attend on the day and participate in the fun.

What to wear:

Students are required to wear a plain white shirt, appropriate pants/shorts/skirt and sneakers. They are also required to wear protective eye wear (goggles or sunglasses) and if they have asthma, a face mask or bandana.

What's New:

There will be 3 large inflatable obstacles as part of the course this year, as well as loads of colour powder and our fabulous local fire brigade spraying the students with water.

Colour Powder:

The colour powder used is made of high-quality corn starch and permitted food colours. It's non-toxic, biodegradable, skin safe and environmentally friendly. Toxicological Risk Assessment and ingredient listings can be obtained from the School Office upon request. Students with asthma are advised to be careful in their decision to participate.

Our Goal:

We are aiming to raise \$12,000. This will get our adventure playground up and running. With your support, we will easily reach this goal.
