2023 School Swimming Scheme

Dear Parents and Carers,

School Swimming Scheme is a 10 day swimming and water safety program that builds water safety skills and confidence for students in Years 2 and 3. The focus is on the development of correct swimming techniques and the development of water safety confidence. Each daily lesson is 45 minutes.

Students who have not reached a satisfactory standard of water safety and survival skills, and are unable to swim 25m confidently unaided in deep water, are strongly advised to participate in the School Swimming Scheme. All Year 2 and 3 students are eligible to attend.

Starting Monday 9th October (first day back) until Friday 20th October

Where:	Glenbrook Swimming Pool, Glenbrook	
Transport:	Students will walk to and from the pool daily under the supervision of their teachers	
Cost:	The total cost for the 10 day scheme is \$43.00 (\$4.30 a day) or you may use a current pool pass, please provide a copy of the pool pass to the office. If you are using a pool pass it must be taken and shown every day for entry into the pool.	
What to Bring:	Each child should bring a swimming costume, 2 towels, a hat, underwear and warm clothing on a cool day. A t-shirt or rash shirt is also recommended. It is recommended that students use adequate sun protection, eg. an SPF 30+ broad spectrum water-resistant sunscreen reapplied regularly.	
Students will be assessed during the School Swimming Scheme for all water safety skills without wearing
